Welcome to Summer Camp Can Do!

The summer camp program will run approximately 11-weeks beginning May 21st and tentatively ending on August 3rd. Like each year, changes have been made to the program to offer a specialized enrichment program for your child.

Registration

Program registration for military dependants will begin on March 1st with DoD civilian and contractors beginning on April 2nd. Come to the Youth Activities Center between the hours of 0930 until 1730 Monday-Friday to register. Summer camp will allow for 90-spaces each week and a waiting list will begin once all slots are filled. You will need the following items at the time of registration:

- ✓ Proof of age and dependant status in the form of either a military ID card, birth certificate, or Page 2 of Active Duty Service Record
- ✓ Most recent LES or two most recent pay stubs for gross total family income verification
- ✓ Family Care Plan for all Single Active and Dual Active Duty parents
- ✓ The first week of camp payment for each child, which includes a non-refundable enrollment fee of \$25.00

Eligibility

Children must be at least 5-years of age by September 1, 2011; currently enrolled in kindergarten; and under the age of 13 throughout the camp session. If a children turns 13 during the summer camp program, they will be eligible to attend the Teen Center Summer Camp Program.

Fees & Charges

Weekly fees are due before services are rendered. A 20% reduction of fees will be applied to each additional child from the same family.
