

## MOTORCYCLE SAFETY TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Operators shall be prepared to operate/ride their motorcycle/scooter on all training days and must have the following in their possession at all times while operating either on or off base:

1. Valid motorcycle license or permit (50cc engine and above), a valid vehicle operators license (49.5cc and below).
2. Valid Motorcycle Safety Foundation completion course card (Expires 3 years from completion date).
3. Current vehicle registration and proof of insurance.

The following protective equipment must be worn at all times by all operators and passengers of motorcycle/scooter: NAVBASEGUAMINST 5560.2C.

1. Long sturdy pants and brightly colored shirt/outer upper garment during daytime (sleeves rolled down to wrist). Military uniforms do not meet this requirement.
2. Over the ankle (sturdy boots) footwear (no athletic shoes).
3. Full-fingered motorcycle gloves.
4. Department of Transportation (DOT)/SNELL Memorial Foundation approved helmet.
5. Brightly colored outer upper garment during the day, a reflective outer upper garment shall be clearly visible and not covered (night time).
6. Shatter proof goggles or helmet visor in down position while in motion.
7. Passengers are only permitted with licensed operators.

### Basic Riders Course (BRC)

DAY 1 (0800-1600 hrs) – Classroom/Range

DAY 2 (0730-1630 hrs) – Range

DAY 3 (0730-1630 hrs) – Range (Day 3 is required if 13 or more students are enrolled)

### Experienced Riders Course (ERC)

(0730-1630) – Range

### Military Sportbike Riders Course (MSRC)

(0730-1800) – Classroom/Range /Classroom

### NOTE:

1. Students are responsible for ensuring they are well rested and prepared for course dates.
2. Enrollment/Cancellations require Command/Activity Motorcycle Safety Representative (MSR) action. For more information, contact the Installation Safety Annex at 339-7233 (SAFE) or 339-5179 / 333-2190.
3. BRC classroom attire is civilian clothes, and all PPE is required on the range.
4. 3 working days after the student has registered in ESAMS, Pass & ID will issue a temporary pass up to the last day of the course; provided the student has all the proper documents for their motorcycle/scooter.
5. 3 loaner motorcycles and 1 loaner scooter are available on a first come first serve basis.
