

Navy to hold Earth Day Fair April 19

(PEARL HARBOR) – Navy Region Hawaii will host its 5th annual Earth Day Fair at the Navy Exchange Mall at Pearl Harbor courtyard, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., on Saturday, April 19. The fair, which is free and open to the public, will include interactive displays, educational exhibits, and various activities to learn about ways to save our planet’s natural resources.
