

IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING YOUR DEPENDENT BAH FOR PERSONNEL ON UNACCOMPANIED ORDERS.

READ CAREFULLY!

The following Personnel who are PCS'ing to Bahrain are entitled to stateside Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH):

1. Married personnel on unaccompanied tour.
2. Single **female** service member with unaccompanied child on her Page2.
3. Single **male** service member with unaccompanied child his page 2 who provides Court Ordered FULL CUSTODY documentation.

***Note: Please try to make sure your page to is accurate and up to date prior to your arrival to NSA Bahrain. Failure to do so may slow/delay your request for BAH Continuance.*

In order to receive BAH benefits all Service Members must provide (1) of the (4) following documentations to Personnel Support Detachment (PSD), upon arrival to Naval Support Activity Bahrain.

1. Proof of current mortgage if Spouse/Dependents are residing in a home the service member (you) are currently paying for / **with utility bill.**
2. Current deed to home if Spouse/Dependents are residing in a home the service member (you) currently own / **with utility bill.**
3. Current lease agreement from an accredited company/agency with the service member (you) or your (page 2) dependents name on it.
 - a. You must provide a **utility bill** with you or your (page 2) dependents name on it.
 - b. Your lease must be current, showing both a Start Date and Termination Date. Expired leases on a month-to month continuation will not be accepted.
4. Service members whose family is residing with family/friends must provide a **notarized** sub-lease contract from the person who owns home/rents property.
 - a. You must provide a **notarized** memorandum from owner/renter confirming your payment of utilities.

**** BOTTOM LINE: In order to receive BAH with dependents, we need to have proof of home/rent so PSD can allow BAH w/Dep based on your location. A Lease or Mortgage, with bill of utility ****

**The same information applies for Service Member requesting Dual-OHA for Spouse/ Dependents residing in a country other than the United States.*

Failure to provide (1) of the (4) above document categories may results in cancellation of your state side BAH.
