TCCOR no longer in effect for JBPHH

PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM – Commander, Navy Region Hawaii has canceled Tropical Cyclone Condition of Readiness (TCCOR) for Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam. According to current forecasts, Tropical Storm Ana is no longer a significant threat to Oahu based on intensity and proximity to the Islands. However, gusty winds and heavy rains and flooding may still be a concern for the Hawaiian Islands based on the storm's current track.

The JBPHH Emergency Operations Center is on stand by and continues to monitor conditions and ensure the safety and security of base personnel. JBPHH continues to be fully mission capable with potential follow-on actions contingent upon weather updates.
