### **HART utilities work on Kamehameha Hwy. to affect Ford Island Bridge traffic on July 28 – 31**

PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM – As part of the ongoing Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) rail project, evening traffic detours will be in effect from July 28 to July 31 when contractors work on utility lines on Kamehameha Highway at the Salt Lake Blvd. and Ford Island Bridge intersection.

From 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., July 28 - July 31, traffic detours will be in effect when entering and exiting Ford Island Bridge. The only access to Ford Island from Kamehameha Hwy. will be from the eastbound direction, turning right onto the Ford Island Bridge. Westbound traffic on Kamehameha Hwy. will not be permitted to turn left onto the Ford Island Bridge.

To access Ford Island from the westbound direction, drivers will have to make a right turn on Salt Lake Blvd. and loop around to enter Kamehameha Hwy. again, in order to approach the Ford Island Bridge from the eastbound direction.

Both the left-turn and straight-through lanes exiting Ford Island will be closed. Traffic will only be allowed to turn right onto Kamehameha Hwy. in the eastbound direction. Drivers proceeding eastbound will be able to make a U-turn at Halawa Drive to travel in the westbound direction.

Honolulu Police Department officers will be onsite to facilitate traffic movement as required.
