JBPBH notifications in support of Pearl Harbor Day events

PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM – In support of the 74th anniversary of National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam residents and personnel should plan accordingly for the following closures and traffic modifications:

Ford Island bridge closure: On Dec. 4, from 9:15 to 10:45 a.m. and Dec. 7 from 7 to 10 a.m., all lanes of the Ford Island Bridge will be closed to motorists and pedestrians in support of the Dec. 7th ceremony rehearsal and commemoration ceremony. Ford Island residents and workers should plan accordingly.

FOX Sports parking lot closures: The following parking lots will be secured at the following dates and times in support of FOX Sports Pearl Harbor Invitational preparations and events that will occur Dec. 3-7. Any vehicles left in the parking areas may be towed at the owner's expense.

- The front and rear parking areas of Bloch Arena to include the parking lots in vicinity of Bldg. 1722 and a portion of the parking area between Bldg. 1722 and Bldg. 1370.
- The parking area on Fifth Street and A Avenue is closed now through 8 p.m., Dec. 8.
- The Mike Pier parking lot located on North Avenue across from Club Pearl will be closed from 4 p.m., Dec. 4 through 11 p.m., Dec. 7.
- The Delta parking lot located on Paul Hamilton Rd. will be closed from 4 p.m., 4 Dec. through 10 p.m., Dec. 5.
- The USS Missouri Memorial parking lot will be closed from 6 p.m., Dec. 5 through 8 a.m., Dec. 6. (excludes Federal Fire Department building parking lot for authorized personnel).
- The Ford Island CDC parking lot and portion of the Ford Island airfield will be closed from 6 p.m., Dec.4 through 8 p.m., Dec. 6.

Traffic and gate modifications on Dec. 7: Heavy traffic is expected at Halawa and Makalapa Gates on the morning of Dec. 7. Base personnel should plan accordingly for the following:

- Starting at 6:10 a.m. on Dec. 7, Halawa Gate will be the main entrance for all invitation-holding guests for the 74th Pearl Harbor Day Commemoration at Kilo Pier 8.
- Due to proximity to Kilo Piers, Makalapa Gate is expected to experience heavy traffic. All commercial vehicles requiring inspection will be re-routed from Halawa Gate to Kuntz Gate.

- Neosho St. and Quincy St. will be closed to allow guests direct access to the event site.
- Personnel with approved access to the installation *not* attending the commemoration ceremony at Kilo Pier are encouraged to use O'Malley, Kuntz, and Nimitz Gates to minimize traffic congestion at Halawa and Makalapa Gates.
- Personnel with base access credentials are welcomed to attend the ceremony (no invitation needed) and may park in general parking areas near the vicinity of Kilo Pier.
- General public without base access credentials wanting to attend the commemoration will be directed to park at Aloha Stadium to take buses to the event.

At 7:45 a.m., Dec. 7, the National Park Service and Navy Region Hawaii will host the 74th Anniversary National Pearl Harbor Day Commemoration ceremony at Kilo Pier 8. Base personnel are invited to attend (RSVP not necessary). Military uniform is summer white or service equivalent. Please do not bring bags or items that offer concealment to the ceremony. Guests without base access will be directed to Aloha Stadium for parking and free bus shuttle transportation to the ceremony. At 7:55 a.m., Dec. 7, the 15th Wing will host a Dec. 7 Remembrance Ceremony at Atterbury Circle to honor the 189 killed and 303 wounded during the attacks at Hickam Field. The ceremony is open to personnel with base access and their sponsored guests.

At 2 p.m., FOX Sports will pay tribute to the nation's military during the Pearl Harbor Invitational NCAA basketball games at historic Bloch Arena. Tip off begins at 2:01 p.m. for the first game between Villanova University and University of Oklahoma, followed by the second game between the U.S. Naval Academy and University of Oregon.
