U.S. Women's National Volleyball Team to Visit Sailors from USS Paul Hamilton

What: Members of the U.S. Women's National Volleyball Team take a break from the court for a tour and meet and greet with Sailors aboard Pearl Harbor-based ship, USS Paul Hamilton (DDG 60)

When: Thursday, July 10, 2014, at 2:30 p.m.

Where: Aboard USS Paul Hamilton (DDG 60) at Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam

Details: The second-ranked U.S. Women's National Volleyball Team is in Hawaii for the USA Volleyball Cup match between Team USA No. 2 and No. 1 Brazil. Brazil defeated USA in the last two Olympic Gold Medal Finals in Beijing and London. The legendary Karch Kiraly, voted Best Male Player of the Century with three Olympic Golds, coaches Team USA. The games will be played at the Stan Sheriff Center on the University of Hawaii campus at 7 p.m. July 11-12. The Navy will participate in the patriotic opening ceremonies at the games.

Guided-missile destroyer USS Paul Hamilton is one of 10 surface combatants currently assigned to Commander, Naval Surface Group Middle Pacific, Destroyer Squadron 31. Guided-missile destroyers are multi-mission anti-air warfare, anti-submarine warfare and anti-surface warfare combatants that operate independently for the support of carriers and expeditionary and surface strike groups.
