Hickam Elementary School hosts Sept. 11th assembly and parade

What: Hickam Elementary School September 11 Remembrance March

When: Friday, September 11, 2015, 9 – 10 a.m.

The event starts at Hickam Elementary School with a commemoration assembly beginning at 9 a.m., followed by a commemorative march. The march will begin at Manzelman Circle, onto Eight and Ninth Avenues, and back to Hickam Elementary School.

About 650 participants are expected, including more than 525 students.
