JBPHH to conduct harbor security exercise on Oct. 7–8

PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM – Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam will hold a harbor security exercise on Oct. 7-8 with activities that can be seen and heard in the vicinity of the harbor. As part of the exercise, blank ammunition simulating live fire and increased activity in the harbor can be expected. Personnel and residents at Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam and in the surrounding community, as well as visitors to the USS Arizona Memorial, Battleship Missouri Memorial and Pacific Aviation Museum, may hear announcements, sirens or other loud noises associated with the training. These exercises are not in response to any specific threat. Basewide exercise announcements via the Giant Voice mass notification system will be made on each day of the exercise.

The harbor exercise is part of Exercise Citadel Protect-15 to enhance the training, readiness and capability of Navy security forces to respond to threats to installations, commands, and units.
