- Painted, Stained or Treated Wood
- Plate Glass
- White Goods - stoves, refrigerators, washers, dryers

AIRFIELD

From Kuntz Gate

Make an immediate right after entering Kuntz Gate. Go to the third warehouse, Bldg. 1715.

From the Main Gate

Enter O'Malley Gate and go under the overpass. Move to the right lane and curve with the road following signs for Kuntz Gate. Just before reaching Kuntz Gate, turn left at the GSA building. Continue straight to the last, third, warehouse (Bldg. 1715).

WATERFRONT

From Nimitz Gate

Turn left on South Avenue. Proceed about 1/4 mile and turn right onto Russell Avenue. Building 159 is about 1/4 mile on the right.

Recycling is Easy!

The Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPHH) Recycling Center has two convenient recycling locations to accept your recyclable goods.

- Airfield - Bldg. 1715
- Waterfront - Bldg. 159

In addition to customers dropping off recyclables at these two locations, other items may be picked up from pre-arranged points, including office areas, and/or collection bins, mini marts, and piers throughout JBPHH.

Commands and activities interested in establishing regular pickup service for recyclables, or who need assistance in transporting large quantities of goods are encouraged to call the JBPHH Recycling Center POC at 474-9207.



Accepted Items

PAPER

White

All white paper, including shredded & manila folders. However, no pulverized or cross cut paper will be accepted. *Note:* All shredded paper must be placed in a clear plastic bag & left at the user's designated recycling area. Large amounts may be dropped off at Bldg. 1715.

Non White, Magazines & Newspaper

All may be mixed together. *Note:* All books (hard & soft cover) must be boxed separately.

Cardboard

Cardboard is collected at various locations via blue bins on JBPHH's Waterfront and special trailers on the Airfield. It may also be neatly stacked at user's designated recycling area near paper recycling. Be sure to flatten all boxes. *Note:* Large drop-offs of cardboard should be made to Bldg. 1715.

PLASTIC/GLASS

All bottles & jars, including glass containers & plastics 1 & 2. *Note:* Be sure to remove tops & rinse containers. No need to remove labels.

TONER CARTRIDGES

All laser toner cartridges, including imaging units transfer rollers, fusers, etc. *Note:* Place all used cartridges in the replacement box or a separate plastic bag.

METALS

All types of metals (ferrous and non-ferrous) are accepted. Metal cylinders need to be out-of-date, valve removed & a hole drilled into the cylinder. *Note:* Metals may only be dropped off during official times at the Bldg. 159 location.

UNTREATED PALLETS

May accept metal, plastic & wood pallets. *Note:* MUST call Recycling Center POC to coordinate drop off of all types of pallets.

Commands & activities may request workplace pick-ups.
