Subj: MISSION, VISION, AND GUIDING PRINCIPLES

1. Below is my Mission, Vision and Guiding Principles statement for NAF Atsugi:

a. Mission: Provide support, service and facilities that enable the combat readiness of Carrier Air Wing FIVE, tenant commands, and forward deployed U.S. forces.
