



## Be aware of your surroundings while on the water

Boaters and Jet Ski riders, please be aware you may not approach within 100 yards of any naval vessel and must operate at minimum speed within 500 yards of any naval vessel.

NSA Panama City has a long-standing no-entry zone extending 100 feet from the shoreline into St Andrew Bay. Beginning at the Hathaway Bridge boat ramp and continuing south towards Pelican Bay, a shoreline barrier is in place; anchored by buoys clearly marked with no trespassing warnings and to stay back 100 feet.

Entry into Alligator Bayou is prohibited and is also clearly marked as a no-entry zone.

Persons violating this no-entry zone are subject to six months imprisonment, a \$500 fine, or both.

### Code of Federal Regulations

§165.2025 of Title 33 covers stand-off distance a private vessel must maintain between a naval vessel and §1382 of Title 18 covers trespassing guidance for boaters.
