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PERSONALLY PROCURED MOVES (PPM) GETTING YOUR MONEY FASTER

Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP), in partnership with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS), has now come up with a way for service members to receive payment for their Personally Procured Moves (PPMs) (formerly known as Do-it-Yourself or DITY moves) via Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) deposited directly into their checking or savings accounts.

Under the former process, after your Personally Procured Moves (PPM) paperwork has been submitted and approved, the Navy Audit Team forwarded an order to DFAS to cut you a check mail it to you. Now, in an effort to expedite the payment process, the Navy will start using the EFT process after your PPM paperwork has been approved. Once DFAS receives the approved paperwork, your money will be DIRECTLY deposited into your checking or saving account within three to five business days.

The Navy PPM Checklist has been updated to include the new, approved EFT form and instructions on how to complete the form. Currently, payment by EFT is voluntary but will become mandatory effective April 1, 2014. There will be a grace period of 60 days to ensure all payments have been processed and paid.
