The United States Navy is committed to protecting the health of their Sailors, civilian staff, and their families by testing for the presence of indoor radon. Indoor radon is monitored throughout NSA Washington following the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) guidelines for sampling and analyzing radon.

WHAT: Radon detectors placed throughout NSAW will be collected for testing

WHEN: Arlington, Carderock, NMIC, USNO: 21 – 25 May 2018

WNY: 21-25 May and 4 - 15 June 2018

WHO: Contractors from MultiMAC JV

WHY: Radon detectors were placed throughout NSAW from May through June 2017 in an effort to assess radon levels in occupied nonresidential spaces.

Results are expected in July 2018 and will be made available to the public on the NSAW Radon Assessment webpage at: www.cnic.navy.mil/NSAWRadon

In addition, any elevated levels will be reported to building occupants within a week of receiving the results via building managers.
