- Command Sponsorship Letter (page 13 to be obtained upon arrival in Rota)
- Immunization record obtained during overseas screening (DD Form 2766C ASIMS)
- Previous school records
- IEP or 504 documentation from previous school or obtained during overseas screening. This will allow for swifter establishment of educational services.
- Birth Certificate or Passport of child/ren for CYP, Sure Start, Kindergarten and 1st grade registrations.
