

Non Dental Beneficiaries Info Sheet

1. **Priority for Routine Care at USNH Naples:** Routine dental care is reserved for Active Duty Service Members, their family members, and certain NATO personnel.
2. **Eligibility for Emergency Care at USNH Naples:**
 - a. **Emergency Care:** Any person presenting with a dental emergency shall be treated, to the extent of stabilizing the emergency, regardless of eligibility.
 - i. **Retired United States Military Personnel and their Family Members.** Treatment for retired personnel is authorized for emergencies (severe, life-threatening, or potentially disabling condition) on a space-available basis.
 - ii. **Eligible Civilians/Government Employees.** Treatment is authorized for emergencies (severe, life-threatening, or potentially disabling condition) on a space-available basis. A fee is charged to those personnel and their family members receiving dental emergency evaluations and treatment.
