



Hania Outdoor Markets

The outdoor “Laiki” (lah-ee-kee), or flea market is where you will find an impressive produce market with fresh fruits and vegetables, cheeses, seafood and even livestock. Amazingly, you will also find everything from clothing, socks, fabric, eating utensils and various household items. Actually, you never know what you may find. The Laiki market is similar to what we know in America as a farmers market.

Come rain or shine, the Laiki takes place 4 days a week, 52 weeks a year*.

MONDAY: 0800-1400 Located in the Amberia area of Hania. Leave NSA, proceed to NAMFI, turn right towards Hania and follow road down to the 1st traffic light and turn left on Antistasios Street (Bakery on your right after turn). Follow road to stop sign and take a left (Vrisson Street). Take your 3rd right (Mantaka Street) and go straight (you'll pass a kiosk on your right). The road turns into a one-way where you have to turn right. Turn right (Emmanouil Mountaki Street). Take your 2nd right onto R. Fereou Street and park your car! Walk back down to Emmanouil Mountaki Street, turn left down Vamou Street. Laiki is on Knossou Street from Vamou Street to A.Papanastasiou.

WEDNESDAY: 0800-1400 Located in the Pahiana area of Hania on Anagnostou Mantaka Street. Follow directions down to Hania. Take left at the stoplight at the bottom of the hill. Take another left at the next traffic light. You're now facing the courthouse. Follow up to circle and take 2nd juncture. (Champion Supermarket will be on your left). Stay on this road. Go thru stoplight. At 2nd stoplight, make a left and then a super quick right (there will be a bicycle shop right there). Stay on this road until you get to Anagnostou Mantaka. Laiki is at the far end of Anagnostou Mantaka Street.

THURSDAY: 0800-1400 Located in the Nea Hora area of Hania. Follow directions down to Hania. Take left at the stoplight at the bottom of the hill. Follow straight into town. You will pass the indoor market on your right. Go thru 3 traffic lights (3rd one will be Halidon Street). After you pass Halidon Street, stay to your right. Turn right onto Pireas Street (where the big Champion Supermarket is), and follow road to the end. Take a left and then veer right. Park wherever convenient. Laiki is right there on the water.

SATURDAY: 0730-1400 Located right in Hania. This is the biggest Laiki and the best of the four. Follow directions down to Hania. Take left at the stoplight at the bottom of the hill. Stay straight into town. Park your vehicle in parking lot across from the stadium. Saturday's laiki is located behind the parking lot on Minoas Street.

*Outdoor market days falling on Greek holidays get transferred to another day of the week.
