DUTIES: Incumbent is responsible for managing daily pool operations including, but not limited to, supervising lifeguard staff, maintaining facility safety and cleanliness, and teaching of in-service training for staff. Assists the Aquatics Director in the training of new employees. Spot checks employees to insure that overall work meets accepted standards. Reports and advises the Aquatics Director on any discrepancies found or personnel problems encountered. Notifies the Aquatics Director of unsafe conditions and infractions of rules and regulations not within the incumbent's authority to correct. Rescues swimmers in distress and promptly administers emergency first aid as needed. Calls for medical assistance when needed. Scans pool area for possible dangers such as falling objects, defective equipment and slippery areas. Maintains cleanliness of the pool and the pool area. Makes a periodic check of chlorine and alkaline levels and records information on appropriate charts.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must have a minimum of six months (6) of general experience and six months specialized experience.

OR

EDUCATION: Successful completion of 2 years of study in an accredited college or university which included at least 12 semester hours of courses about, or related to recreation (**Copy of transcripts is required**).

KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED BY THE POSITION:

- 2) Must possess a current American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer certificate.
