DUTIES:

Employee safeguards and supervises swimmers and bathers in pool area. Enforces swimming and bathing regulations. Continuously observes swimmers, stays alert for any situations which may pose hazards to a person's life, health or safety. Warns swimmers of unsafe conditions and actions. Takes action to remove the hazards or to have the individual(s) causing the hazard to leave the pool area or cease the activity. Rescues swimmers in distress and promptly administers emergency first aid as needed. Calls for medical assistance when needed. Scans pool area for possible dangers such as falling objects, defective equipment and slippery areas. Maintains cleanliness of the pool, the pool area and locker rooms. Makes a periodic check of chlorine and alkaline levels and records information on appropriate charts.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must be able to pass American Red Cross Lifeguarding, R-94, Certificate Includes First Aid and Safety. **Must have a current Italian Lifeguarding Certificate.**

In addition to the required certificates applicants must have a minimum of six months (6) of general experience, which indicates ability to acquire the particular knowledge, and skills needed to perform the duties of the position.

OR

Successful completion of one (1) year of education above high school level in any field for which high school graduation or the equivalent is a prerequisite may be substituted for the experience at the Ua-07
