PAX TERMINAL : Bldg 436, 24 hours daily, Telephones (commercial and DSN capability, TV, Restrooms, Family and Special Category Lounge. DV/VIP: Bldg 436, 24 hours daily.

BILLETING: On Base: this is 24-hour manned location to assist you in your billeting arrangements. Quarters are limited, and it is recommended that you call ahead for availability at 624-2300/6832. The Navy Lodge is located on NAS I, DSN 624-4082. Off base: there are many hotels in the local area. The following list is for the convenience of our customers. Taxi Service on and off base available 24 hrs a day. A more economical way of getting to Catania is by using public transportation system. The bus is by far the cheapest and easiest. The public commercial bus system passes in front of the Support Site Base, NAS I To catch the bus, make your way to NAS I by using the free base shuttle bus service.

It is advised that you have the correct change in Euro. This bus will terminate at the Catania train station downtown Catania. The train station is the main bus transfer point for most Catania and local destinations. To get back to base, catch the blue bus that is marked for "Ramacca".
