



VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND LICENSING FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL

DRIVERS LICENSE:

- All in-office visits related to driver licenses or state IDs are by appointment only. To make an appointment, visit <https://alohaq.org>. Appointments are ONLY available to those whose driver's licenses and state IDs have an expiration date between 1 March and 31 July 2020. Licenses that expired between 15 March and 15 May 2020 are automatically covered by a 90 day extension. If your license is lost, stolen, destroyed or illegible request a new license online at <https://www1.honolulu.gov/duplicates> or call (808) 768-9100.

VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION:

- Safety inspection certificates that expired in May 2020 or prior, will be valid through 31 August 2020. Safety inspection stations reopened on 15 May 2020 and will be by appointment only. VEHICLE REGISTRATION (HONOLULU, HAWAII):

- All Satellite City Halls are closed for in-person visits, and are scheduled to reopen on 1 July 2020. City staff continue to work on requests submitted through mail, online (<http://www12.honolulu.gov/mvrreg/>), or via self-service kiosk (Safeway and other).
- For military members wishing to register vehicles using a tax exempt form, please adhere to the following:
 - o Forms can be obtained from your military personnel unit, unit admin, or unit S-1.
 - o Hawaii residents on active duty and members of the National Guard and Reservist and who are assigned to units in Hawaii are authorized to use one CSL (MVR) 50A form for a vehicle registered in their name.
