1. Purpose. Per references (a) through (i), enclosure (1) promulgates policies, standards and procedures for entry to all properties under the jurisdiction of Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPHH) for the purpose of safeguarding personnel, facilities and property. This instruction defines the responsibility of the installation commander in establishing, implementing and sustaining scalable base operating support related access control procedures.


2. Cancellation. JBPHHINST 5510.1 dated 22 Sep 11.

3. Scope. This instruction is applicable to personnel requiring access to property under the jurisdiction of the installation commander. Strict adherence must be exercised over access to JBPHH in order to protect JBPHH assets from potential threats and to prevent interference in the orderly accomplishment of the mission of JBPHH. Operational, security and safety considerations are vital in establishing procedures to govern entry to the installation. This instruction may be amended by the Joint Base Commander at any time without written notification. All Changes will be updated annually.

4. Action. All JBPHH activities and tenant commands are required to comply with the access requirements established in this instruction.

a. Commanding Officers, Officers in Charge, contractors, facility managers and tenant activities may issue badges, identification (ID) cards or activity passes to enhance internal controls within their respective areas of responsibility; however, these forms of identification will not serve as identification/authorization to access JBPHH or installations through entry control points.

b. Department Heads, Commanders, Officers-In-Charge and sponsors will ensure personnel passes, badges and special identification media are returned to the issuing agency upon dismissal, termination, transfer of an employee or upon expiration of such items.
