NAVSTA PEARL INSTRUCTION 5700.1C

Subj: DOD PARTNERSHIP IN EDUCATION PROGRAM

1. Purpose. To establish guidance pertaining to the Naval Station Pearl Harbor participation in the Partners in Education (PIE) Program with elementary, intermediate and high schools in the Pearl Harbor area.
2. Cancellation. NAVSTAPEARLINST 5700.1B.
3. Background. Navy family members residing in the Pearl Harbor immediate vicinity attend several elementary, intermediate and high schools within the area. They comprise a highly visible and well-defined segment in local public school population, especially since they are a transient population and differ culturally to some extent from a substantial number of their fellow students. The purpose is to offer the considerable wealth of skills, knowledge and experience of the Navy community and make them available to school students.
4. Discussion. References (a) and (b) encourage voluntary educational partnership between schools and private/public sector organizations. The NAVSTA PEARL PIE Navy personnel involved in this program have wide discretion regarding program involvement; they may conduct tours, provide educational materials, give lectures, tutor and provide other assistance as required by participating elementary, intermediate and high school teachers. Navy personnel are provided an opportunity to develop skills as speakers and educators and to become involved in beneficial community activities. Through this program, the Navy and Naval Station also develop positive images in the local community and enhance their recruitment and enlistment programs.
5. Guidance. Participation in the program is voluntary and at the discretion of the Commanding Officer, Naval Station, Pearl Harbor. Supervisors may authorize adjustments to normal duty and work schedules to permit participation by military and civilian personnel. However, such activities should not hamper or hinder the accomplishment of assigned military missions.

6. Action

a. The Naval Station Family Service Center (FSC) will be the Station's liaison with the participating schools-Radford High, Aliamanu Intermediate, Pearl Harbor Kai Elementary-and will work with the schools' designated representatives to establish possible areas of support. The FSC will obtain volunteers from the Naval Station community and provide their names, duty telephone numbers and other information, as appropriate, to the respective school's designated representatives. Volunteers will work directly with teachers in their common areas of interest to

provide assistance to the school. Voluntary commitment by Naval Station and tenant activity personnel will be solicited and/or renewed annually in June for the following school year. Volunteers will keep the FSC informed of activities they have conducted or plan to conduct with their school counterparts. Volunteers are assigned to the PIE Management Team as a collateral duty.

b. Department Heads are strongly encouraged to provide the Station's liaison with at least one representative for the PIE Management Team. Monthly meetings are held the second Tuesday of each month at FSC.
