DESCRIPTION:	The purpose of this course is to provide EPA-accredited certification training for Navy military and civilian workers and supervisors involved in all classes of asbestos removal operations. Graduates will acquire a one-year US EPA certification as "Asbestos Supervisor" and be registered in the Virginia DPOR database. Course content includes asbestos removal, control, and disposal procedures, health and personal protection, review of US federal and state regulations, along with recent developments in state-of-the art procedures.
ELIGIBILITY:	Navy military and civilian personnel assigned to perform or supervise all classes of asbestos removal operations. Persons requiring initial certification and personnel with certification, but have not been recertified in over 2 years should attend this course.
