



Asbestos Supervisor Refresher (CIN: A-493-0070)



DATE/TIME:	14 & 15 January 2014 (0800-1600) (Two sessions-select the date)
COST:	None
DESCRIPTION:	The purpose of this course is to provide EPA-accredited, annual recertification training for Navy military and civilian workers and supervisors involved in all classes of asbestos removal operations. Graduates will acquire a one-year EPA recertification as "Supervisor." Course content includes a review of federal and state regulations, along with recent developments in state –of-the art procedures.
ELIGIBILITY:	Navy military and civilian personnel assigned to perform or supervise all classes of asbestos removal operations who have acquired initial EPA certification and require annual recertification. Personnel must bring to class evidence of initial Asbestos Supervisor/Worker certification in order to receive their recertification certificate. Persons requiring initial certification may not attend this course.
