Subj: ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Ref: (a) OPNAV-M 5090.1

1. Commander, Fleet Activities Sasebo (CFAS) is committed to the development, implementation and management of an effective Environmental Management System (EMS). EMS is a framework for environmental stewardship that applies to all tenants and activities operating on CFAS which monitors the following:

- a. Protection of the environment and pollution prevention efforts.
- b. Compliance with environmental regulations and Department of Defense (DoD)/Navy policy.
- c. Continual improvement of the EMS and enhanced environmental performance.


2. EMS will be integrated into business processes, cost-effectively resourced, evaluated quarterly via the Environmental Protection Council to ensure objectives and targets are advanced and compatible with the strategic direction of the base and reviewed annually. A risk-based approach is utilized to assess work practices and processes on CFAS at high-risk locations, locations that have potential for adverse impacts to the environment, the Mission and host-nation relations.

3. The Environmental Division will monitor EMS implementation and conduct environmental walkthroughs of high-risk locations ahead of weekly zone inspections. Tenants are expected to support this effort, to promptly close findings, and work with the Environmental Division to continuously improve efforts to protect the environment and preserve natural resources.

4. EMS awareness training is a key part of environmental stewardship at CFAS. All DoD military, civilian and Master Labor Contract/Indirect Hire Agreement personnel must complete the training within six months of their on-board date and every three years afterwards. Limited Terms Employees and US/Japanese contractors must complete it prior to their start date. Training is monitored via the Environmental Compliance Assessment, Training and Tracking System (<https://environmentaltraining.ecatts.com/home>). The Environmental Division will provide hard-copy training briefs and rosters upon request.

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5. The Environmental Division, Public Works Department Sasebo will serve as the EMS administrator for all commands on CFAS. My point of contact is the Installation Environmental Program Director at DSN: 315-252-3369.
