Route 1: One ticket for the entire trip. Total fare is ¥900.

1. At **YOKOSUKA CHUO Station**, buy a ¥900 transfer ticket to **ROPPONGI Station** via the **TOEI-OEDO Subway Line**.
****Note**** To buy a transfer ticket, touch the following buttons on the screen:
<<<English →Ticket →Connecting Ticket tab →Change at Toei Line →Ticket fare amount>>>
2. Go to **Track #2** and take a train with either a GREEN or RED Kanji sign bound for Yokohama/ Shinagawa.
****Note****
~ Trains with a RED Kanji sign run **from 5am to 8:30am and from 4:30pm to 6:30pm only**.
~ If you take a train with a RED Kanji sign, stay on it until you reach DAIMON Station (A09).
After Shinagawa Station, Keikyu Line merges with the TOEI ASAKUSA Subway Line.
~ If you take a train with a GREEN Kanji sign, exit at SHINAGAWA Station, but stay on the same platform.
Take any of the next trains to DAIMON Station (A09; 3rd stop from Shinagawa Station).
3. Get off at **DAIMON Station (A09)** and transfer to the **TOEI-OEDO Subway Line** (purple circle) bound for Shinjuku at **Track #4**.
4. Get off at **ROPPONGI Station Exit #3** (E23; 3rd stop from Daimon Station on the TOEI-OEDO Subway Line).

Route 2: Two tickets for the entire trip. Total Fare is ¥930.

1. At **YOKOSUKA CHUO Station**, buy a ¥770 transfer ticket to **ROPPONGI Station** via the **JR YAMANOTE Line**.
****Note**** To buy a transfer ticket, touch the following buttons on the screen:
<<<English →Ticket →Connecting Ticket tab →Change at Shinagawa JR Line →Ticket fare amount>>>
2. Go to **Track #2** and take a train with either a GREEN or RED Kanji sign bound for Yokohama/ Shinagawa.
****Note**** **If possible, get on one of the last two cars of the train. This will make it easier and faster to find the entrance to the JR Lines at Shinagawa Station .**
3. Get off at **SHINAGAWA Station**. Take the stairs up and follow the elevated walkway near the end of the platform. Go through the wicket machines to enter the JR Line area. **Do not forget to retrieve your ticket**. Go to **Track #2** of the **JR YAMANOTE Line** bound for SHIBUYA and SHINJUKU. **EBISU Station (H02)** is the **4th stop** from Shinagawa Station.
4. Get off at **EBISU Station** and use the **West Exit (西口)** to transfer to the **HIBIYA Subway Line** (gray circle) located outside of the station. After going through the wicket machines, turn left and walk all the way to the end of the hallway. Then, take the escalator going down toward the street level and the entrance to the HIBIYA Subway Line.
5. Buy a ¥160 subway ticket, go to **Track #2**, and take a train bound for Ginza and Ueno.
6. Get off at **ROPPONGI Station Exit #3** (H04; 2nd stop from Ebisu Station on the Hibiya Subway Line).

From Ikego:

1. At **JIMMUJI Station**, buy an ¥830 transfer ticket to **ROPPONGI** on the TOEI OEDO Line for **Route 1** or buy a ¥700 transfer ticket to **EBISU Station** on the JR YAMANOTE Line via **SHINAGAWA Station** for **Route 2**. **See note in Step #1 above**.
2. Go to **Track #2** and take a train to **KANAZAWA HAKKEI Station**. From there, transfer to a **KEIKYU MAIN LINE** train at **Track #3** with either a GREEN or RED kanji sign bound for **SHINAGAWA Station**.
3. **Continue with notes in Step #3 above in the directions of “Route 1: ~” or in Step #3 in the directions of “Route 2: ~”.**

Walking directions from Roppongi Station

The Embassy is approximately ten (10) minutes walking distance away from Exit No. 3 of the Roppongi Station via the Tokyo Metro Hibiya Line or the Toei O-Edo Line.

1. Follow Gaien Higashi Dori in the general direction of the Tokyo Tower.
2. Turn right upon reaching the intersection with a traffic light where Gaien Higashi Dori crosses Toriizaka street. You will notice the ROI Building and a Subway Sandwich outlet at the corners.
3. After turning right, continue on walking towards the direction of the next nearest traffic light where you will find a pedestrian crosswalk in front of the Minato Ward Azabu Shisho (branch office) situated to your left.

For **non-Consular related business**, turn left at the very first corner after the Azabu Shisho. Walk toward the end of the road where you will find the Embassy main gate to your right.

If you have business at the **Consular Section** (e.g. visa, passport, report of birth, marriage, divorce, notary and others), turn left at the second corner after the Azabu Shisho. Continue on walking as you will shortly reach the Consular Section entrance to your left.
