<p>6. 職務内容 Duties</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Performs inspections and maintenance on various types and sizes of fire extinguishers, such as water, dry chemical, carbon dioxide, and halon for proper condition and operation. Conducts all maintenance work for Naval facilities throughout Japan, such as Yokosuka Main Base Complex, Ikego Housing, Taura Ordinance, POL/Ammo Azuma, Negishi Housing, POL Tsurumi, POL Koshiba, NAF Atsugi, NSF Kamiseya, NRTF Totsuka, Sanno Hotel, and Sasebo. Work includes replacement of defective gauges, hoses, and other minor parts. Disassembles, inspects and repairs of all parts as needed. Repaints, cleans and maintains a ready stock of extinguisher needed to meet mission requirements.</li> <li>2. Maintains record, files, and reports, set schedules and places orders for parts or replacement of extinguishers and agents.</li> <li>3. Performs regular fire prevention inspections of buildings, structures, and areas in accordance with the laws, regulations, and/or guidelines provided. Maintains building record reports and files.</li> </ol>			

6. 職務内容 Duties (Cont'd)

- Researches and recommends corrective actions to prevent or control fire hazards.
4. Reviews building blue prints and floor plans, performs special inspections and/or tests of buildings, fire protection systems/equipment under construction or major repair/modification. Performs special inspection and issue approval for open fires of repair work on buildings, structures including Ammo storage and Fuel storage tanks. Conducts fire evacuation drills. Performs special inspections of hazardous materials/conditions specifically assigned by the supervisor or directed by the higher authority.
  5. Prepares various reports/statistics and maintains records concerning fire prevention inspections, open fires, fire evacuation drills, fire protection systems, fire extinguishers, and/or inspection performances, etc. extinguishers for US Military personnel, their dependents, JN employees, base contractors, and/or members of JMSDF.
  6. Conducts fire prevention and public education classes and/or demonstrations of fire extinguishers for US Military personnel, their dependents, JN employees, base contractors, and/or members of JMSDF.
  7. Performs other related or incidental duties as assigned.

\*Must be able to distinguish black, white, blue, red, green, orange, yellow, lime-yellow, blue and purple colors to perform fire prevention inspection on equipment categorized by color codes.

- b. Must have or be able to obtain Fire Inspector I certification.

Former US Military Members: Please attach DD Form 214 Copy (Member-4 copy) to your application. Former military retirees must first obtain approval for employment under foreign government from the Chief of Naval Personnel and attach the approval letter to be considered.
