PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT 個人情報保護について

AUTHORITY: Executive Order 10450, 9397; and Japan Law Concerning Protection of Personal Information (Law No. 57 of 2003).

Quality Control Specialist, #390

1. Assumes the responsibilities of Project Quality Manager (PQM) specified in NAVSHIPREPFACINST 4790.2.

The PQM is the point of contact for all Quality Assurance matters related to all ship repair work conducted by contractors.

Determines the effectiveness of the contractor's approved Quality Management System (QMS) by conducting Procedure Evaluation (PE), Product Verification Inspection (PVI), and Document Review (DR) in-process surveillances, and completes/submits Past Performance Information (PPI) Surveys of contractor Quality performance at the end of each availability to Code 200 FISC ACO.

Prepares the SRF-JRMC quality oversight plan before the start of each availability based on the Test and Inspection Plans submitted by all contractors, the controlled and non controlled work to be conducted by contractors during the availability, and the work to be performed by Alteration Installation Teams (AITs), and ensures accomplishment of required contractor oversight surveillances. Also performs random surveillances of AIT work and Ship Engineering Maintenance Assist Team (SEAMAT) work.

Ensure all testing required for completion of CWP/PCP is complete and reviewed prior to the tended ship reactor plant startup, propulsion plant startup, or getting underway or a Departure From Specification (DFS) for non-nuclear systems has been submitted and approved as necessary. Ensure all test results are completed, properly documented and the QA forms are returned to the CWP except for those specifically designated as work center records.

For tasks 2 through 4, assumes the Quality Assurance Inspection role for In-House Work, and the Contractor Oversight role for contracted work along with the associated duties and responsibilities for the following trade areas: Hull, Machinery, Electrical/electronics, and Boiler/ piping.

2. Reviews Controlled Work Packages (CWP) and Contractor Process Control Procedure (PCP). Performs opening reviews of CWP/PCP as assigned to assure Objective Quality Evidence (OQE) generated will support work recertification. Performs closing reviews of CWP/PCP as assigned to assure technical accuracy and satisfactory OQE exists for record history.

Performs QA inspections of critical certification attributes to ensure all work inspected meets the requirements set forth in the latest applicable plans, specifications and directives of higher authority as stated in the CWP/PCP. Verifies permanent markings on controlled material are properly transferred and new material control tags are affixed as required for Controlled Material Signs QA form 2's as controlled material is correctly installed for Level-I Systems and ensures that OQE is properly documented by the responsible trade area craftsmen as specified in the Joint Fleet Maintenance Manual (JFMM) Vol. V and specifically requested by the Maintenance Work Order (MWO). Ensure all personnel use only Test, Measurement and Diagnostic Equipment (TMDE) (i.e. measuring devices, instruments, inspection tools, gauges, jigs or fixtures), which have current calibration stickers/records attached or available, for production, acceptance and testing. Uncalibrated/untested TMDE will be tagged and removed from service immediately.

Witnesses and verify testing and inspections as specified by the MWO, and immediately informs supervisors of unsatisfactory test results.

Supports QA audits, and conducted assigned in-process surveillance of both in-shop and contractor work and coordinates corrective actions ensure compliance with specification.

3. Implements the SRF-JRMC Contract Administration Quality Assurance Program (CAQAP) per JFMM Vol. VII including all G-Point inspection per NAVSEA Standard Item.

4. Schedules and conducts periodic Audits and Surveillance on the Contractors Quality Management systems. Reports corrective actions when required, and evaluates responses for adequacy.

5. Performs other duties as assigned.
