Residents in the vicinity of NAS Oceana, and other interested parties, are invited to attend a public information meeting to learn about the Navy's plans to sample drinking water from private wells near NAS Oceana to determine if they contain perfluorinated compounds (PFCs)/poly- and perfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). The Navy used fire-fighting foam containing PFCs/PFAS in past training activities on NAS Oceana.

The meeting format will include informational displays, and representatives from the Navy, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry, the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality, the City of Virginia Beach, and the Virginia Department of Health will be present.
