Subj: UNAUTHORIZED DUMPING ONBOARD NAVSTA NEWPORT

1. Purpose. To publish policy governing the unauthorized dumping onboard NAVSTA Newport.
2. Cancellation. NAVSTANPTINST 9656.1.
3. Background. It is the NAVSTA Newport policy to not allow personnel to use the trash dumpsters on base for the disposal of personal trash brought from home or outside the base. There has been a significant increase in the number of complaints received regarding individuals who are bringing their household trash, large pieces of junk and even hazardous materials onboard NAVSTA and dumping it into the government funded trash dumpsters located throughout the base. This causes trash dumpsters to overflow, results in loose trash blowing around the base and often makes it impossible for base personnel to use the dumpsters for official business. This unauthorized dumping directly contributes to the rapidly increasing costs associated with NAVSTA's trash disposal.
4. Action
 - a. All personnel are prohibited from bringing onboard NAVSTA any garbage, waste, junk or other debris from home or from other locations outside of the base for the purpose of dumping in base dumpsters or other locations throughout NAVSTA.
 - b. All personnel found to be in violation of this instruction will be subject to having their base driving privileges and/or base access privileges suspended by the NAVSTA Commanding Officer.
