Domestic Violence Awareness Month – Fleet and Family Support Center (FFSC) Gulfport would like to remind you that **October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month** - Domestic violence is defined as a pattern of abusive behavior in any relationship that is used by one partner to gain or maintain power and control over another intimate partner. Domestic **violence can include physical, sexual, emotional, economic, psychological actions or threats of actions** that influence another person. The color purple of the awareness ribbons is to recognize victims of domestic abuse as well as to celebrate survivors. Emotional Abuse happens when someone insults, humiliates, or uses "mind-games" to control another person. Emotional abuse doesn't always lead to physical violence, but almost all physical or sexual abuse includes emotional abuse. Being emotionally abused puts a victim at risk of physical abuse. What are the signs? The abuser may be very controlling and make all the decisions, act very possessive, have a need to win every argument, may demand sex after an argument to "make up." The abuser may verbally discount feelings/views of the victim and intimidates the victim. The victim may be in denial and make excuses for the abuser's behavior, blames him/herself, believes abuser's behavior is a sign of love. **The victim may suffer from low self-esteem and questions his/her own perceptions, may self-isolate and changes how he or she acts to avoid making the abuser angry.**
