Security Note

Operation Identification was created to protect your personal belongings and discourage theft and burglary on board NCBC. Operation Identification requires permanently marking your valuables with a personally created code. Create a code starting with (USN); add a nickname or favorite place & you can add numbers or symbols. You are only limited by your creative ability to create a personal code. Use the same code on all valuables. Consider engraving or use an Ultraviolet Light Pen where markings cannot be seen with the naked eye. A documented listing of the items you marked should be kept in an area along with your other important papers. Operation Identification helps Local Law Enforcement, Pawn Shops, Security and you to readily identify stolen valuables.

Flushing Hydrants and Closing Roads

From Nov. 15-17, construction work will impact traffic along Marvin Shields Blvd, in the vicinity of the Branch Health Clinic. The attached map shows the location of this work. In this area, Marvin Shields Blvd will be limited to a single lane of traffic. Signage and flaggers will enable two-way traffic flow through this single lane, but travelers should expect some delays.

Gulf Coast Veteran's Day Parade

The Gulf Coast Veteran's Day Parade will begin rolling down the street at 11 a.m., Nov. 12 from the D'Iberville Stadium on Lamey Bridge Road in D'Iberville. The parade will travel south on Lamey Bridge Road to D'Iberville Boulevard (Central Avenue) and continue south on Central Avenue to Rodriguez Street. It will turn west on Rodriguez and continue north on Automall Parkway to Ginger Drive finally turning west on Ginger Drive. It will disband behind City Hall.

The Reviewing Stand will be on the west side of Automall Parkway at Ginger Street. The Parade will culminate at the Red White & Blue Festival behind City Hall at the D'Iberville Civic Center Pavilion with Static Military displays, live Entertainment, Arts/Crafts, Food and informational vendor booths.
