Flushing of Fire Hydrants

Public Works is flushing fire hydrants North of 7th Street to South of 9th Street and East of Gilbert Avenue to Olson Avenue, Oct. 31 from 7 a.m. to Nov. 2 at 3:30 p.m. Flushing may cause some sediment in the piping to break free that results in possible cloudy water in the vicinity of the work being performed. It is PWD's recommendation to let the water faucets run for several minutes to let these sediments that break free, clear. The buildings affected include 18, 19, 20, 182, 200, 271, 272, 273, 274, 275, 276, 319, 321, 322, 323, 329, 404, 416, 436, & 465. Buildings 428, 429, 432, 433, 470 along with CED buildings may also be affected.
