

Typical Materials:

TIRES -

- Location - MWR's Auto Hobby Shop
- Time – normal working hours

FLUORESCENT BULBS –

- Prepare - Mark the date removed from service on the bulbs in indelible ink or with tape/marker
- Location - HW Bldg 276
- Time - normal working hours

BATTERIES –

- Mark the date removed from service on the bulbs in indelible ink or with tape/marker
- Location - HW Bldg 276
- Time -normal working hours

**DIRECTIONS FOR VARIOUS
RECYCLABLE MATERIALS:**

PAPER -

- Any color, size, shape, free of contaminants!
- Place in designated containers for weekly collections
- No Container? NO PROBLEM call Recycling Center – we deliver!

CANS/PLASTIC BOTTLES -

- Rinse and place in containers
- Place at roadway on collection days

WOOD -

- Place in dumpster on Pad Bldg 425, west of the Recycling Center.
- Call Recycling Center to obtain used lumber for CBC Projects.

CARDBOARD -

- Collection devices in various locations at CBC are clearly identified
- Or bring to the container outside Bldg 275 anytime / any day!

SCRAP METAL -

- Drop off at Recycling Center at any time
- Dumpster located east of building.
- No contaminants, wood, plastic, tires, batteries, fuels, or appliances with freon
- Appliances will be taken by appointment only after they are certified refrigerant-free

TONER CARTRIDGES -

- All are accepted
- Preferably in original box or in plastic bag
- Bldg 275, Recycling Center
- Accepted only during normal working hours
