HOUSING DEPARTMENT

The Naval Air Station (NAS) Meridian Housing Department consists of Family Housing (FH) that supports military families, Bachelor Housing (BH) that supports unaccompanied service members including unaccompanied Student Naval Aviators, Visitor's Quarters (VQ) that supports transient guests, and Dormitories (DORMS) that supports enlisted students. The FH office is located in 718 Gill Street and is open from 0700 to 1530, Monday through Friday (except federal holidays). The FH telephone number is DSN 637-2520 or commercial (601)679-2520. The BH Reception Center is located in Building 218 and is open 24-hours. The BH telephone number is DSN 637-2186 or commercial (601)679-2186.

FAMILY HOUSING

1. **BACKGROUND.** We would like to be your housing of choice! Over the past five years, the Navy has spent in excess of twenty-five million dollars renovating Meridian's FH assets. NAS Meridian now provides some of the most modern FH homes in the Navy. Considering the distance and commute time from most off-base housing, rent, high utility rates, escalating transportation costs, and the proximity to all military support services, Family Housing is your best, safest, and most secure housing option. Additionally, the local public schools provide transportation service for all students who attend public schools.

All families, regardless of size, will have access to a minimum of three bedrooms. Families that meet the requirements will have access to a four bedroom units. If you choose to live in town but later decide that you prefer to live on base, you must have applied for on base housing within 30-days of initial arrival to be eligible for a government-funded move later.

Naval Air Station, Meridian's Family Housing (FH) was privatized effective 1 October 2007. While there were many changes, most were transparent to families living in the FH units. One notable change was that the Navy started paying you BAH. In turn, this is the rental rate the Partner charges for monthly rent. There are several ways to pay your rent, but probably the best way is through a monthly allotment. Upon arrival, you will first meet with a Navy member of the FH staff. This staff member will answer most of your questions, and then refer you to the Partner.

2. **ELIGIBILITY.** All permanent party military and Student Naval Aviators (SNA) with accompanying family members are eligible for on-base housing. Normally, the composition of family members determines the size and number of bedrooms. Incoming PCS service personnel and their families may make reservations for temporary lodging not to exceed 30 days at the VQ.

3. **MFH CONTROL DATES AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES.** The date of detachment from your last duty station is your control date for assignment to NAS Meridian FH. You must submit an application package to include a formal Housing application, a copy of your PCS orders, and a copy of your current Record of Emergency Data (Page 2). The FH Office will also require a copy of your detaching and reporting endorsement to verify your control date. Application for MFH is made on a DD Form 1746, Application for Assignment to Housing. This form is available at most Family Housing Offices or on line at www.housing.navy.mil. You may submit your application in person or by fax to DSN 637-9097 or (601) 679-9097. If more convenient, you may mail your application to: Family Housing Manager, CNRSE Family Housing Office, 718 Gill Street, Meridian, MS 39305. We encourage you to send us an advanced copy of your orders so that we can provide you with the latest information on NAS Meridian housing. Submitting an advanced application will not place your name on the waiting list for base housing.

4. **ASSIGNMENT WAITING LIST.** When required, the FH office keeps a waiting list for assignment to FH. This list is based on bedroom entitlements within each category.

5. **BEDROOM ENTITLEMENT BASED ON FAMILY COMPOSITION.** Bedroom entitlements for personnel in pay grades O3 and below are based on family composition and size. The spouse is not included when determining family size. Department of Defense, Navy, subordinate command instructions, and NASMERINST 11101.1H establish the following entitlements:

6. **BEDROOM ENTITLEMENT BASED ON GRADE.** Bedroom entitlements for personnel in pay grades E7-O4 and above are based on pay grade or family size and composition, whichever drives the larger requirement. Additionally, NAS Meridian has identified specific units for Command Master Chiefs, the Senior Enlisted Marine from MATSS-ONE, NAS Meridian Commanding Officer, and the Commander, Training Air Wing One.

Personal preference for a specific type house, number of bedrooms, or location is not a consideration when determining assignment.

7. **FH INFORMATION.** Family housing units are all-electric and equipped with central heating and air conditioning, single carports, electric ranges, refrigerators, dishwashers, and garbage disposals. All units have connections for personally owned washers and dryers. Each unit has an exterior storage room. Family Housing also has 105 10'x 10' storage units available for housing occupants on a space available basis. You can get more information on the storage units by contacting the FH Office. NAS Meridian has the following type housing and locations:

Capehart Housing. Juniper Ridge and all of Pine Crest. This area provides housing for 63 officer and 34 enlisted families. These units were completely renovated in 2004 and consist of three and four bedroom duplexes that include 11 senior officer and 4 senior enlisted single units.

ATTENTION TO SERVICE MEMBERS: Acceptance and move-in to government quarters is for the duration of your tour at Naval Air Station Meridian. Permission to move off base must be obtained prior to vacating government quarters, and obtaining housing off base. This can be accomplished by submitting a special request authorization to the Housing Office for approval by the Commanding Officer of Naval Air Station Meridian.

OFF-BASE HOUSING

1. **Apartment Complexes.** There are approximately 18 privately owned apartment complexes in the surrounding area. Most units offer one to three bedrooms. Occasionally, there is a shortage of units. Four bedroom units are available, but at a much higher cost. The monthly average rental rate, excluding utilities is:

1 Bedroom from \$350.00-\$650.00

2 Bedrooms from \$450.00-\$750.00

3 Bedrooms from \$550.00-\$850.00

2. **Mobile Home Parks.** There are approximately 7 mobile home parks near NAS. Several rent two and three bedroom trailers. Monthly prices range from \$250.00 to \$500.00 Space is available for privately owned trailers with lots renting for \$85.00 to \$170.00 a month.

3. **Rental Housing.** There is a shortage of available/affordable houses in the immediate Meridian area. Most landlords require a twelve-month lease, one month's rent in advance, and a security deposit equal to one month's rent. If the landlord accepts pets, deposits will normally range from \$150 to \$300. Most pet deposits are not refunded. The average rental rate, excluding utilities, is as follows:

2 Bedrooms from \$350.00-\$800.00

3 Bedrooms from \$550.00-\$1,500.00

4 Bedrooms from \$800.00-\$1,600.00

4. **Houses for Sale.** The price of an average three bedroom, two bath brick home is \$85,000 to \$150,000. Prices vary depending upon location, condition, age, and amenities. Contact the Family Housing Office for more information.

5. **House Hunting Orders.** We strongly encouraged those interested in renting apartments or houses to schedule their house hunting leave no earlier than 30 days before detachment.

BACHELOR HOUSING (BH)

1. **BACKGROUND.** BH consists of three different sections. The permanent party section provides housing for all military personnel assigned to NAS, Meridian or tenant commands personnel on Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders. Visitor's Quarters provides housing to all military and civilian personnel ordered to NAS, Meridian or tenant commands in a temporary additional duty or similar status. The Dormitory (DORM) section provides housing to all enlisted students ordered to one of the various service schools. Regardless of your status, the high standards we keep in our BH depend on your full support. Our sole purpose is to provide you with the most modern, pleasant living environment possible.
2. **ELIGIBILITY.** BH assets are available to all active duty, reserve, and retired service members. In some cases, command may authorize family members to use BH facilities if private bath facilities are available.
3. **ASSIGNMENT.** Permanent party residents and VQ guests should report to Building 218 for room assignment. Newly reporting NTTC students will report to the NTTC Quarterdeck located in Building 360. USMC students will report to the Duty Office in Building 353. Both locations are open 24-hours a day.
4. **ENTITLEMENTS.** Various Department of Defense, Chief of Naval Operations, Commander, Naval Installation, and Commander, Navy Region Southeast instructions determine BH entitlements. Permanent party personnel in pay grades E1-3 may elect to live in the local area and be authorized Basic Allowance for Housing once BH spaces are fully occupied. Transient personnel will normally be assigned to the VQ unless there are no adequate spaces available or they have been issued a certificate of nonavailability before arriving at NAS, Meridian.
5. **RESERVATIONS.** Permanent party residents and VQ guests can make reservation 24-hours a day by calling the BH Reception Center at DSN 637-2186 or commercial (601) 679-2186. All enlisted students should report according to their written orders.

AIR OPERATIONS

MERIDIAN, NAS



Training Air Wing ONE was commissioned on August 2nd, 1971. The mission of Training Air Wing ONE is to provide newly designated aviators to the fleet for further training in operational combat aircraft and is conveyed in the wing motto, "Readiness for Victory at Sea Through Training." The Wing Commander's specific mission is to supervise, coordinate, and administer the student pilot academic and flight-training program. The instructor pilot cadre at Training Air Wing ONE is comprised of men and women from almost every Navy and Marine Corps aviation community as well as several international military exchange pilots, bringing an enormous array of fleet experience to the training command. Training Air Wing ONE is also tasked with training international military aviators from countries including France, Italy, and Spain.

Subordinate commanders under Commander Training Air Wing ONE include **Training Squadron SEVEN** and **Training Squadron NINE**. Training Wing ONE receives Student Naval Aviators upon completion of Primary Flight Training in the T-34C Turbommentor and the T-6B Texan. Training Squadron SEVEN and Training Squadron NINE train Student Naval Aviators in the Boeing T-45C Goshawk, the Navy's most advanced strike jet trainer. Upon completion of Advanced flight instruction, the Student Naval Aviators are designated Naval Aviators and receive their "Wings of Gold."

AIR OPERATIONS SUPPORT

The Air Operations Department consists of two airfields, McCain Field and Joe Williams Airfield and Air Traffic Control services at McCain and Joe Williams Airfields

Flight Operations at McCain Field totaled 235,282, including 8,391 radar approaches. There were 33,890 flight operations at the Joe Williams Outlying Field. Services are limited to Class "D" airspace and PAR/ASR final approaches. Air Traffic Control currently has 49 controllers assigned.

The Field Support Division operates and maintains eight sets of E-28 arresting gear between McCain Field and Joe Williams Field. Field Support is also responsible for the handling/services of transient aircraft and salvage operations. Field Support Division currently has 27 military and 4 civilians assigned to its division.

The Ordnance division is responsible for the receipt, handling, inventory, assembly, storage and issue of conventional arms ammunition and explosives (AA&E) at NAS Meridian. Ordnance is responsible for maintaining records, preparing reports and messages concerning Arms, Ammunitions and Explosives at NAS Meridian. Ordnance contains three military and five civilians assigned to its command.

Ground Electronics ensures that all assigned UHF, VHF, and FM radio communication, air navigational aids, weather monitoring/reporting equipment and precision approach radars required to conduct safe and effective flight operations at NAS Meridian and its outlying field operate at or above designated performance standards. They provide base-wide sound support services and serve as point of contact for matters related to 3-M, frequency management, and equipment configuration. There are two military and sixteen civilians assigned to the Ground Electronics department.

VT-7 "EAGLES"



The "Eagles" of Training Squadron SEVEN (VT-7) have the mission of safely and effectively training the world's finest Naval Aviators and preparing them for service and success in the Fleet. Student Naval Aviators train for approximately twelve months in the fundamentals of strike aviation. Initial flights and simulators are devoted to Instrument Flight Rules, culminating in an instrument rating. In the Familiarization stage, students learn basic aircraft maneuvering, aerobatics, and landing skills foundational to the aircraft carrier environment. Numerous multi-aircraft flights provide requisite skills in two-plane, four-plane, and night formation flying. The second phase of flight training exposes students to manual air-to-ground bombing, Tactical Formation, Air Combat Maneuvering, and Operational Navigation at low altitude. Finally, students perform Field Carrier Landing Practice (FCLP) in preparation for their Carrier Qualifications (CQ). In order to become "tailhookers" and earn their Wings of Gold, students must safely complete four touch-and-goes and ten arrested landings aboard a carrier at sea.

VT-7 originated as a Naval Advanced Training Activity located at Naval Air Station Memphis, Tennessee. It was initially composed of two advanced training units. These were consolidated into Basic Training Group SEVEN, which employed the T-28 "Trojan" and T-29 "Seastar" to train student aviators in basic instrument flying. BTG-7 was designated as VT-7 in July, 1960, and relocated to NAS Meridian, Mississippi, one year later. VT-7 then split to form a "sister" squadron, Training Squadron NINE (VT-9) in December, 1961. In 1964, VT-7 won its first of eighteen Chief of Naval Operations Aviation Safety "S" Awards. A superior safety record and an aggressively professional approach to safeguarding lives and aircraft enabled the Command to again receive the CNO Safety Award in 2008.

The T-2 "Buckeye" was used in VT-7 from 1962 until 1971. The Command then transitioned to the Douglas TA-4J "Skyhawk" to train pilots for advanced strike missions. The first advanced strike student earned his Wings of Gold in the spring of 1972. The last Naval Aviator trained by VT-7 in the TA-4J graduated in 1999 when VT-7 transitioned to the Boeing T-45C "Goshawk." In its first year of Goshawk service, VT-7 flew over 18,000 sorties and made nearly 1,300 carrier landings. From January 2008 to May 2009, the Squadron flew more than 24,455 hours and winged 82 students trained by a staff of 45 Active Duty and 25 Reserve Instructor pilots. To date, the "Eagles" of VT-7 have winged more than 3,900 Naval and Marine Corps Aviators including 331 International Students from France, Italy, Kuwait, Spain, Thailand, Singapore, Taiwan, and Brazil.

VT-7's Eagles are dedicated to their mission of training Student Naval Aviators, and will continue providing the fleet with the finest Naval Aviators in the world.

VT-9 "TIGERS"



Training Squadron NINE (VT-9) is the third naval squadron to be designated VT-9. The first VT-9 was commissioned in 1927 as a torpedo squadron, flying the Curtiss T-3M Convertible Land/Seaplane. The second VT-9 was commissioned on December 15, 1961 at McCain Field, U.S. Naval Air Station, Meridian, Mississippi. On August 2, 1971, the VT-9 "Tigers" branched off to form its "sister" squadron, designated VT-19 "Frogs", and both squadrons then assumed the intermediate jet training role at Meridian. Training Squadron NINE was disestablished in July 1987 and consolidated with Training Squadron NINETEEN. On October 1, 1998, Training Squadron NINETEEN was re-designated as Training Squadron NINE and the "Tigers" were again reborn. In June 2004, the squadron completed the last Student Naval Aviator flight in the T-2C "Buckeye."

Presently, VT-9 is under the command of Commander Craig Snyder, USN. Its mission is to safely train Student Naval Aviators for the United States and other International Navies in the air strike mission. The squadron has trained International students from Spain, France, Brazil, and Italy.

Training Squadron NINE currently operates the Boeing T-45C "Goshawk". Civilian maintenance contractors maintain the 89 T-45C aircraft flown by VT-9. Fidelity Technologies Corporation operates the T-45C flight simulator for the squadron.

Student Naval Aviators and International Military Students are aboard VT-9 for approximately nine to twelve months and are trained in all of the fundamental stages of strike aviation. Many initial flights and simulators are devoted to Instrument training, which eventually culminates in an instrument rating. Sixteen day and four night flights are then devoted to the Familiarization stage. Here, students learn basic aircraft maneuvering, aerobatics, and carrier landing skills. Twenty-three Formation flights provide students the sound skills in both two and four plane Formation flying. These flights lay the foundation required during later tactical events. In the Weaponry stage, students learn fundamental ground weapon delivery procedures. Four Night Formation flights are followed by 10 flights focused on the basics of Air Combat Maneuvering. Finally, the students fly Field Carrier Landing Practices (FCLPs) in preparation for carrier qualifications, which consist of 4 touch-and-go landings and 10 carrier-arrested landings aboard a carrier at sea. Following this, the students receive their "Wings of Gold".

Training Squadron NINE's unprecedented safety record has culminated in ten Chief of Naval Operations Aviation Safety Awards. In 2005, the squadron was awarded the CNO Safety "S" from CNATRA. Training Squadron NINE's other recent awards include two Secretary of the Navy Meritorious Unit Commendation awards and the 2009 Vice Admiral Goldthwaite Training Excellence Award.

BASE DECAL AND MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION

1. **BASE DECALS** – Base decals remain current for three years or for the duration of current enlistment, whichever is earlier. Personnel must obtain their decal within 30 days of reporting aboard. The Pass and Tag office is located at the Main Gate in Building 221. The DSN telephone number is 637-2509. The commercial telephone number is 601-679-2509. The following information is required when reporting to the Pass and Tag office:
 - a. **IDENTIFICATION** – Proper Department of Defense identification.
 - b. **CURRENT VEHICLE REGISTRATION** – Vehicles of Armed Forces personnel must be registered in their name or in the name of their bona fide dependents.
 - c. **VALID DRIVERS LICENSE** – Armed Forces personnel must present a valid drivers license from their home state (state of record) or the state in which their vehicle is registered. Their family members must present a valid license issued either by the state of Mississippi or the state in which the vehicle is registered. Applicants for motorcycle decals must furnish proof of completion of a military sponsored Motorcycle Safety Course.
 - d. **INSURANCE** – Applicants must present evidence or appropriate certification of compliance with the Mississippi Motor Vehicle Responsibility Act. Coverage must be shown for a minimum of 3 months from the date of base decal registration. The insurance must cover the vehicle and the driver and carry the following minimum coverage to be in compliance with Mississippi State Laws:
 - (1) **PUBLIC LIABILITY:** \$ 25,000 per person
\$ 50,000 per accident / bodily injury
\$ 25,000 property damage
 - e. **EFFECTIVE SAFETY INSPECTION CERTIFICATION** – Vehicles registered in states having safety inspection laws must display effective inspection stickers, either from the state of registration or the state of Mississippi.
2. **MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC STOPS** – You are required to remain in your vehicle should you be stopped for an infraction of motor vehicle regulations aboard NAS Meridian. This is for your and the Patrolman's safety. Also, you will be required to produce the above documents at all times.



CHILD DEVELOPMENT HOME PROGRAM

Purpose of the CDH Program

To ensure standards for the care and protection of children away from their homes, encourage/assist Child Development Home (CDH) providers, and work for the development of additional services for the family. CDH is defined as care provided by private individuals in their on or off base home.

The CDH provider is anyone in the military community (dependents, reservist, or retirees of any branch of the service) who has completed training certification requirements. These include inspection by safety, fire and preventative medicine, Infant/Child CPR, First Aid and Food Sanitation training and approval of the Commanding Officer. CDH providers continually work to improve their home care by using the Family Day Care Rating Scale. They are required to do the Navy Provider's Training Program, which consists of 14 modules. These modules help them develop their skills in appropriate learning experiences for young children and provide a support system to ensure that the providers comply with these standards.
