NASPNCLA INSTRUCTION 1500.6H

Subj: TRAINING FOR OPERATION OF VEHICLES ON SHERMAN FIELD

Ref: (a) NAVAIR 00-80T-114
(b) FAA AC 150/5210-20

1. Purpose. To establish responsibilities and procedures for training and certifying airfield vehicle operators.

2. Cancellation. NASPNCLAINST 1500.6G

3. Action

a. All military, civil service, and temporary contract personnel who operate a vehicle on Sherman Field shall attend the Airfield Indoctrination Course.

b. The Air Operations Air Traffic Control Division shall schedule and conduct training for all personnel. Classes shall be convened as required to accommodate a maximum of 30 personnel.

c. After completion of the indoctrination course, students will be required to complete and pass a written test. Upon satisfactory completion of the written test, a class completion sheet will be turned in to the Air Traffic Control Facility Officer. The individual will be authorized to drive on the airfield for a period of 1 year, unless revoked by the Commanding Officer or other competent authority. Each activity shall develop procedures to ensure their personnel attend indoctrination classes annually in accordance with references (a) and (b).

d. A request will be submitted from each activity to the Air Traffic Control Facility Officer (2-4671), Building 3963, listing the number of personnel required to attend the indoctrination course. All students must possess a valid state driver's license. Classes will be convened to meet the requirements of each activity, consistent with the requirements of subparagraph 3b above.

4. Other commands. Temporary contract personnel and tenant commands shall comply with the provisions of this instruction.
