Was there a Memorandum of change (to a December 2009 policy guidance) issued in March of this year that would have amended TWIC holder access to military installations?
Do we honor Transportation Workers Identification Credentials (TWIC) for access to this installation?
PLEASE DO NOT DO ANY RESEARCH - I was called about it by a member of Senator Reeds staff but it is only an informal question so no need to work on it - if you have the memo or a current policy that we're following that addresses TWIC access, just let me know the number and I'll send it along for the staff to read.
Please, just let me know.

Capt. Boyer, XO - (b) (6) said that the American Transportation Association (ATA) is "circling" the wagons in D.C. regarding TWIC holder access being revoked back in March. Her question to me was informal for background b/c a representative of ATA is reaching out to various staffs with military bases in their districts. Perhaps Navy Region Mid-Atlantic would appreciate a heads up but I do not think that we want to pull this thread by formally requesting a congressional inquiry on it - perhaps the Army can sort this out for all of us if this is a DOD change and not just a Navy policy change. If the policy was changed then so be it but it would be helpful to Sen. Reed's staff to know if this is something that is impacting many RI truck drivers - by educating his staff they can take care of the constituent complaints themselves....

Training is required for gate sentries to understand the Merchant Mariner credential, TWIC, access list piece.
