This is in response to your complaint submitted to the Department of Defense Office of Inspector General, who in turn forwarded it to the Office of the Naval Inspector General on April 8, 2016, in which you alleged that the authority of the Naval Station Newport, Rhode Island has collectively comprise the remaining Supervisory Civilian GS-0083 series Police Officers. You continued by stating that throughout the past year they have unsuccessfully exhausted their internal and external chains of command to resolve ongoing intolerable, hostile and potentially unsafe working conditions at NAVSTA Newport.

We have reviewed the information you provided and determined that your allegations are not appropriate for investigation by this office; therefore, NAVINSGEN will not open an investigation into your complaint.
