Transition Goals, Plans, Success Workshops

Requirement concerning Pre-Separation Counseling:

Pre-Separation Counseling is initiated through with your Command Career Counselor (CCC) or Command Transition Officer (CTO) 24-18 months remaining before retirement; 18-12 months prior to separation; and not less than 90 days remaining on Active Duty whether retiring or separating pursuant to 10 U.S.C. 1142. Service members must complete a Pre-Separation Counseling Checklist, DD Form 2648 for Active Duty Personnel, or a DD Form 2648-1 for Reserve Personnel, and the following additional requirements:

- DD Form 2648/DD Form 2648-1 completed less than 90 days must contain explanatory remarks summarizing the reason(s) why Pre-Separation Counseling was not completed prior to the 90 days.
- Received an overview of Transition GPS Components
- Explanation of Career Readiness Standards (CRS)
- Information and assistance with eBenefits Registration
- Information and assistance completing the O*NET Interest Profiler or Kuder Journey Assessment
- A copy of the Individual Transition Plan (ITP)
- For additional guidance contact your CCC or CTO to schedule your counseling session, complete pre-requisite work, and schedule to attend the Transition GPS Workshop.
