This Warning Order (WARNORD) supersedes reference (a) and promulgates the way-ahead for the "Implementation of Transition Goals Plan Succeed (GPS)."

1. SITUATION:

a. As addressed in reference (a), attached is the tentative CNIC/Region/Installation schedule for the upcoming site visits. N91 has emailed the attached spreadsheet out to your N91s this week for scheduling confirmations and CO office call time slots.

b. Reference (b) announced the rollout of revisions to the Transition Assistance Program (TAP) resulting in the "2012 Transition Goals, Plan, and Succeed (GPS)" initiative.

c. CNIC HQ will deploy an Implementation Team to Navy Installations with Transition Assistance Programs, as defined in reference (a) and announced in reference (b).

2. MISSION: To provide the CNIC Enterprise a heads-up that a GPS implementation Team will be visiting various installations to conduct an initial assessment. The assessment will provide briefs to leadership, determine gaps in facilities and equipment and develop mitigation strategies to fully implement Transition GPS.

3. EXECUTION: 1 Oct 12 through 1 Mar 13.

4. APPLICABILITY: All CNIC HQ/Regions/Installations with Transition Assistance Programs.

5. COORDINATING INSTRUCTIONS:

a. Region COSs: Please ensure dissemination of this WARNORD to Installation COs, Region N91, and other applicable personnel.

b. Enclosure (1) notifies installations, via their Regions, of tentative visit dates except where still being confirmed.

c. Region N91s shall complete and validate enclosure (1) providing feedback to HQ N91 NLT COB 10 Oct 12.

d. As part of the GPS Assessments, N91 shall:

(1) Provide a briefing for the Installation Commander during the scheduled visit, if desired.

(2) Meet with Fleet and Family Support Directors, Transition Managers and other stakeholders including Public Works and Information Technology personnel, if deemed necessary, to discuss gaps and potential mitigation.

(3) Conduct on-site inspections of current and potential spaces and equipment.

(4) Complete all site visits no later than 1 Mar 13.

f. Installation participation: Installation Fleet and Family Service Center (FFSC) Directors and Transition Assistance Program (TAP) Managers shall plan to be engaged for the duration of the site visit. Triad Leadership (CO/XO/CMC) and Public Works Officer participation and support are also encouraged.

6. LOGISTICS: Implementation Team travel will be coordinated by CNIC N9 and the contract company.

7. FUNDING: CNIC HQ will fund all site visit travel.

8. PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS: CNIC N91 staff, Region/Installation Fleet and Family Support Directors, and GPS contract company

9. REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS:

a. CNIC will provide status reports to Installations, via the region, within 30 days of site visit. Implementation updates will be provided every 30 days until mitigation is complete.

b. CNIC N9 will include GPS implementation status in the weekly reports provided to N00.

10. STRATEGIC COMMUNICATIONS GUIDANCE: CNIC HQ and OPNAV N135 PAOs have developed a Strategic Communications Plan for Transition GPS. The STRATCOM will be promulgated upon approval from OSD.
