Subj: COMPREHENSIVE RESOURCE GUIDE FOR UNACCOMPANIED HOUSING

1. Purpose. To provide a comprehensive resource document identifying all references governing the operations and management of the Navy's Unaccompanied Housing (UH) Program.

2. Policy

a. The UH Comprehensive Resource Guide provides a list of relevant statutes, instructions, policies and guidance governing the Navy's UH Program. It also identifies where to find the documents electronically.

3. Responsibilities

a. Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC) N93 is responsible for ensuring the UH Program is operating in accordance with the policy and standards identified in the UH Comprehensive Resource Guide.

b. Region Commanders (REGCOMs) are responsible for providing assistance to the installations with the implementation of the UH Program in accordance with the policies and standards identified in the UH Comprehensive Resource Guide.

c. Installation Commanding Officers (COs) are responsible for implementing the UH Program in accordance with the policies and standards identified in the UH Comprehensive Resource Guide.

4. Actions

a. CNIC N93 shall disseminate changes in policy and standards to ensure the UH Program is operating in compliance. At a minimum, the UH Comprehensive Resource Guide will be validated and redistributed annually.

b. REGCOMs shall disseminate any changes in policy or standards to ensure the UH Program is operating in compliance at the installation.

c. Installation COs shall implement any changes in policy or standards to ensure their UH Operations are managed in accordance with Navy guidance.
