The Transition GPS program not only provides information and assistance to service members considering separation or retirement, but also welcomes spouses to participate in workshops; these workshops include employment, resume writing, VA benefits, relocation, and financial planning.

Transition-GPS

The Transition-GPS program assists service members separating from the military to make good career decisions and transfer their military experience into a civilian job or career. Service members will be able to analyze their skills and experiences, identify needs and goals, conduct a successful job search, and obtain information on their veteran's benefits.

Career Options and Navy Skills Evaluation Program (CONSEP) First-term

CONSEP is a new breed of training in which you'll be informed inspired and entertained while improving your knowledge and ability to manage your career adventure. CONSEP fulfills the promise of "Accelerate Your Life" through acceleration of your career. CONSEP will provide you with insight into the various aspects of managing a career, financially, professionally and personally.

CONSEP Mid-Career

This program assists mid-career sailors identify individual skills and talents, develop long-term professional and personal goals, plan for personal financial stability, research related civilian skills or qualifications, establish effective long-term planning objectives, and most importantly, the values of continuing their navy career.

Boots to Business

This 2-day workshop assists participants in understanding the steps, stages, and activities related to launching and growing a business as a post-military career, as well as how business ownership might align with their own personal strength and life goals.

Accessing Higher Education

This program guides transitioning service members and spouses through the process of determining career paths, selecting a degree program, comparing accredited colleges, examining funding options including the GI Bill and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and completing a college application package.

Career Technical Training

This program is for transitioning service members who are interested in a trade or technical field that may require a certificate or license. Participants are guided in choosing the right career, determining what additional training may be needed, exploring funding, and finding the right institution.
