### Notes:

1. This is a flexible position.
2. Selected candidate is required to pass a background investigation, State check, and a physical examination as conditions of employment.
3. Applicants must be at least 18 years old.
4. If selected, civilian personnel must provide this office with official/no-fee passport, official orders/ command-sponsorship authorization, and sojourner's permit/application letter.
5. Position requires constant standing, walking, and lifting of objects weighing up to 40 lbs.
6. Incumbent is exposed to extreme temperatures due to walk-in refrigerator and to steam and heat from cooking and dishwashing.

**How to Apply:** Applicants must submit: (1) Application form (OF 612 or Résumé) containing required information listed on the reverse side of this announcement; (2) Overseas Residency Questionnaire; (3) Family Member/Military Spouse Supplement; and (4) OF 306, Declaration for Federal Employment. Veterans must also submit copy of DD-214 (and SF-15 if claiming 10-point preference).

**Area of Consideration:** **U.S. citizens** in the commuting area who are authorized sponsors or command-sponsored dependents of civilian and military personnel.

**Description of Duties:** Assists in food preparation with tasks such as peeling potatoes; cutting and washing vegetables and fruits; assembling sandwiches; and measuring and weighing ingredients. Stocks food service carts with utensils, plates, food and beverages. Transports food from kitchen area to classrooms or activity areas. Washes pots, pans, dishes and silverware in a dishwasher or manually. Cleans food preparation and related areas. Operates, breaks down and cleans electrical equipment. Labels and dates all items in refrigerators and freezers. Stores items in food storage area. Unloads food and supplies from delivery trucks. Moves garbage cans from the work area to the disposal area. Performs other related duties as assigned.

### Qualification Requirements

Description of prior work experience must show possession of the following job elements:

1. Ability to do the work of the Food Service Worker without more than normal supervision.
2. Knowledge of food handling techniques, sanitation principles and safe work procedures.
3. Ability to read and understand written materials in English such as standard operating procedures, menus, recipes and work instructions.
4. Knowledge of basic arithmetic.
