

YOKOHAMA MINATO MIRAI 21 (MM21)

Built mostly on reclaimed land, Minato Mirai 21 literally means “port of the future” with “21” representing the 21st century. This futuristic bayside project includes office spaces, shopping malls, museums, restaurants and hotels. Landmark Tower, Queens Square, Ferris wheels, and the Red Brick Warehouse are some of the major attractions in this area, and all are easily accessible from Yokohama Station.

BY TRAIN

From YOKOSUKA:

1. At **YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station**, buy a ¥480 transfer ticket to **SAKURAGICHO Station (桜木町駅)** via the **JR KEIHIN-TOHOKU/NEGISHI Line (JR 京浜東北線・根岸線)**.
****Note**** To buy a transfer ticket, touch the following buttons on the screen:
<<<English → Ticket → Connecting Ticket tab → Change at Yokohama JR Lines → Ticket fare amount>>>
2. Go to **Platform #2** and take a train with either a GREEN or RED kanji sign bound for **SHINAGAWA (品川)** and **YOKOHAMA (横浜) Station**. Yokohama is the **4th stop** (green-kanji sign train) or the **6th stop** (red-kanji sign train) from YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station.

****Note**** If possible, get on one of the last two cars of the train. This will make it easier and faster to find the entrance to the JR YOKOHAMA Line (JR 横浜線; GREEN-striped trains).
3. Get off at **YOKOHAMA (横浜) Station**, use the **CENTRAL EXIT (中央口)** stairs, follow the signs toward the wicket machine entrance toward the JR Line platforms. **Do not forget to retrieve your ticket.** Go to **Platform #3** and take a **JR KEIHIN-TOHOKU/NEGISHI Line (JR 京浜東北線・根岸線)** train bound for **OFUNA (大船駅)**.
4. Get off at **SAKURAGICHO Station (1st stop from YOKOHAMA)** and leave the station to the left, which will take you to the expansive plaza outside. You will see the Landmark Tower and MM21 development in front of you.

From IKEGO:

1. At **JIMMUJI (神武寺) Station**, buy a ¥430 transfer ticket to **SAKURAGICHO Station (桜木町駅)** via the **JR KEIHIN-TOHOKU/NEGISHI Line**.
2. Go to **Platform #2** and take a train to **KANAZAWA HAKKEI (金沢八景) Station**.
3. Get off at Kanazawa Hakkei Station, go to Platform #3, and transfer to a **KEIKYU MAIN LINE** train with either a RED or GREEN kanji sign bound for **SHINAGAWA (品川) Station**.
4. **Continue with Step #3 above.**


BY CAR

From YOKOSUKA:

1. Turn right at the main gate onto Rt.16. After driving past Daiei Mall, stay in the right lane, and take the ramp to **HONCHO-YAMANAKA (本町山中) Toll Road**. Pay **¥200** at the tollgate and keep left at the 1st fork to **YOKOHAMA YOKOSUKA 横浜横須賀 (YOKO-YOKO) Toll Road**. Take a ticket at the next tollgate and keep right at the 2nd fork toward **YOKOHAMA**.
2. Go straight following the signs for **HACHIOJI**. Pay **¥900** at the **KARIBA** tollgate.
3. After the **KARIBA** tollgate, take **SHUTO EXPWY K3 Line**.
4. At **ISHIKAWACHO JUNCTION**, take **SHUTO EXPWY K1 Line** toward **YOKOHAMA Station**.
5. Stay in the left lane and exit at **MINATOMIRAI** which leads directly into the MM21 area.

From IKEGO:

1. After exiting through Ikego gate, go straight, then turn left at the 7-Eleven intersection onto Rt. 24.
2. At the 6th stop light, turn right onto the ramp to **Yokohama-Yokosuka (横浜横須賀道路) Toll Road**.
3. Take a ticket at the tollgate, keep left at the fork, and follow the signs toward **YOKOHAMA (横浜)**.
4. **Continue with Step #2 above, except pay ¥800 at the Kariba tollgate.**
