

# TOKYO SKY TREE

"Tokyo Sky Tree" opened in the Narihiraishi/Oshiage area of Sumida Ward, Tokyo in 2012. Boasting a height of 634m, the tower is one of the world's tallest. One of Tokyo Sky Tree's main purposes is as a television and radio broadcasting tower. Tokyo tower (height 333m, 1093ft) in Minato ward was no longer tall enough to give complete digital terrestrial television broadcasting coverage, because it is surrounded by many high-rise buildings. The tower has restaurants, shops and observation deck. Visitors can "enjoy walking in the sky" and the great view. At the foot of the tower is a "town with a tower" spans about 400m from east to west, connecting Oshiage Station and Narihiraishi Station, and encompassing an area of about 3.69ha. There are restaurants, shops, aquarium, dome theater (planetarium), etc.

## From YOKOSUKA:

1. At YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station, buy a ¥950 transfer ticket to **OSHIAGE (押上) Station** via the **TOEI ASAKUSA Subway Line (都営浅草線)**.  
**\*\*Note\*\*** To buy a transfer ticket, touch the following buttons on the screen:  
<<<English → Ticket → Connecting Ticket tab → Change at Toei Line → Ticket fare amount>>>
2. Go to **Platform #2** and take a train with either a GREEN or RED kanji sign bound for **SHINAGAWA (品川) Station**.  
**\*\*Note\*\***  
~Trains with a **RED** kanji sign run from **5am to 8:30am and from 4:30pm to 6:30pm only**.  
~Take any train with a RED kanji sign, **except** for the one with sign for **HANEDA AIRPORT**. Continue on until you reach OSHIAGE (押上) Station.  
~If you take a train with a GREEN kanji sign, get off at SHINAGAWA Station, but stay on the same platform. Take any of the next trains to OSHIAGE (押上) Station.
3. Get off at **OSHIAGE** Station.

## From IKEGO:

1. At JIMMUJI (神武寺) Station, buy an ¥880 transfer ticket to **OSHIAGE (押上) Station** via the **TOEI ASAKUSA Subway Line (都営浅草線)**. See note in Step #1 above.
2. Go to **Platform #2** and take a train to **KANAZAWA HAKKEI (金沢八景) Station**. Transfer to **KEIKYU MAIN LINE** train with either a GREEN or RED kanji sign bound for **SHINAGAWA (品川) Station**. See notes in Step #2 above.
3. Get off at **OSHIAGE** Station.

## RETURN TRIP

### To YOKOSUKA-CHUO:

1. At **OSHIAGE (押上) Station**, buy an ¥950 transfer ticket to **YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station** via the **TOEI ASAKUSA Subway/KEIKYU Line (京急線)**.
2. Go to **Platform #1** and wait for a train with a either GREEN or RED kanji sign bound for either **MISAKIGUCHI (三崎口)** or **KEIKYU KURIHAMA (京急久里浜)**. Get off at **YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station**.

### To IKEGO:

1. At **OSHIAGE (押上) Station**, buy an ¥880 transfer ticket to **JIMMUJI (神武寺) Station** via the **TOEI ASAKUSA Subway/KEIKYU Line (京急線)**.
2. Follow Step #2 above in the directions "To YOKOSUKA CHUO", except getting off at **KANAZAWA HAKKEI (金沢八景) Station**, and transfer to a local train bound for **SHIN-ZUSHI (新逗子)**. Get off at **JIMMUJI (神武寺) Station**.
