### NAVAL STATION (NAVSTA) NEWPORT INSTRUCTION 5090.18A

From: Commanding Officer, Naval Station Newport

Subj: ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW OF CONTRACTS AND PROJECTS

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5090.1C

1. Purpose. Per reference (a), establish requirements for review of plans, projects, special projects, self-help projects, military construction projects, directives, Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) and instructions.

2. Cancellation. NAVSTANPT/LOCAL AREA RI COORDINST 5090.18

3. Background. Reference (a) requires the establishment of a formal program whereby environmental professionals must participate in a review of plans and specifications for facility projects, including both special projects and military construction projects, directives (SOPs) and instructions that involve work with potential environmental concerns, specifications for purchases/contracts developed by facilities, purchase requests, contracts, and engineering design specifications.

4. Scope

a. This instruction applies to all Naval Station (NAVSTA) Newport Departments and Tenant Commands.


5. Policy

a. As required by reference (a), this instruction establishes and implements an Environmental Review Program for projects and contracts at all NAVSTA Newport Departments and Tenant Commands.

6. Action

a. The Environmental Office will perform review of local plans and projects, self-help projects, directives (SOPs) and instructions, military construction projects and special projects.

b. Originators of plans and specifications for all facility projects, including both special projects and military construction projects, and directives, SOPs and instructions that involve work with potential environmental concerns, shall coordinate with cognizant environmental personnel to ensure that they have considered applicable environmental requirements. Where facilities develop specifications for purchases/contracts, the activity organization responsible for purchase requests, contracts, and engineering design specifications shall coordinate with cognizant environmental personnel.
