

NAVAL AIR STATION JACKSONVILLE
BASE POPULATIONS GROUPING
(based upon evacuation status)

Critical Personnel:

- Remain onboard during evacuation
- Only those that can be housed safely
- Remain in place during incident - No travel orders required
- Dependents receive EVAC ORDERS

Essential Personnel

- Needed for recovery
- Evacuated during storm
- Evacuate to Safe Haven or other rally point, return to assess damage, restore essential services
- Remain in proximity to rally point to ensure availability for rapid return to installation
- TAD ORDERS (to/from rally point); installation generated, DTS if available
- Dependents receive EVAC ORDERS

Non-Essential Personnel & Residents

- Required for normal operations and tenant missions
- Presence after severe storm interferes with recovery
- Not needed for life safety missions during the storm
- Non-Essential Personnel released earliest
- All evacuate to safe haven/broad area if mandatory evacuation ordered
- Evacuate to Safe Haven/designated area, return to installation when directed by ICO
- May disperse within specified distance from Safe Haven but must maintain contact with Safe Haven Muster Cell
- Members & dependents receive EVAC orders

Tenant Commands

- MUST follow ICO Evacuation Order, get approval in advance for "critical" personnel
- MAY select different Safe Haven
- Should coordinate ICO of Safe Haven location, status, and update muster data regularly
- EVAC Orders funded by ISIC

Tropical Cyclone Conditions (TCCs)/Conditions Of Readiness (CORs)

TCC COR 5 – Destructive winds possible within 96 hrs.

TCC COR 4 - Destructive winds possible within 72 hrs.

TCC COR 3 - Destructive winds possible within 48 hrs.

TCC COR 2 - Destructive winds anticipated within 24 hrs.

TCC COR 1 - Destructive winds are occurring or anticipated within 12 hrs.
