Dear Landlord,

Currently the U.S. Navy is conducting a public health evaluation for U.S. military personnel, civilian employees and their families living in the Campania region. This assessment will evaluate and characterize any adverse effects of the environment (specifically the air, the soil, and the water). This effort is part of the Navy's commitment to the health and well-being of its Navy family.

We appreciate your role, as a landlord, in providing quality housing for our personnel. This letter is to inform you about what you can expect to see, and perhaps participate in, regarding this evaluation.

Over the next few months environmental professionals will be testing air, soil and drinking water at military facilities and residences throughout the Campania region. Not every residence will be tested, but we want to keep everyone informed.

The sampling effort will begin with a pilot test with a few homes selected based on geographic considerations. This sampling will help determine the next steps necessary. Should your property be selected for either the pilot or greater study test, we will coordinate with you and your tenant. Attached is a letter we are sending to our residents. Our residents will also receive a copy of this letter. Testing results will help us resolve any potential health and environmental concerns, which will ensure success for future property rentals. If testing reveals specific concerns, landlords will be informed and may be asked to take some corrective action.

We are working closely with Italian government officials. Providing a quality experience for our families while living in Italy remains key to our vision of a creative, diverse and professional team. We place particular emphasis on quality of life for our families and your cooperation is indeed greatly appreciated.
